[ML&S Stepping Up Dogs Off-Leash Enforcement](#)

The City of Toronto is encouraging residents to be responsible pet owners and keep their dogs on a leash at all times. Last year, bylaw enforcement officers undertook a

public education and enforcement blitz in July. This year's focus will be on city-wide enforcement.

In 2014, there were a total of 829 investigations regarding dogs running off-leash. There were 161 charges laid. This year to date, there have been 924 investigations and 39 charges laid. A fine of \$360 can be issued for allowing a dog to run at large except in a posted designated leash-free area. Owners are responsible for their dog and any injuries or damage caused by any dog in their care.

In order to use the leash-free zones, dog owners must have vaccinated, licensed and neutered or spayed their dogs. Dogs that are aggressive to humans, dogs with a history of biting, and other types of animals are not permitted in the leash-free zones.

[Traffic Calming Request for Glen Ellen East - Update](#)

Councillor Justin Di Ciano has also requested that staff investigate the additional options (above and beyond speed humps, bump-outs and speed cushions) for a traffic circle at Ballacaine Drive and Glen Ellen East.
