## **TTC Streetcar Track Replacement on Lake Shore Blvd West**

Weekend partial intersection closure at Lake Shore Blvd. W and Park Lawn Road

### **Issue / Background:**

- This briefing note provides an update to the TTC Streetcar track replacement currently taking place over four km between Dwight Ave and the Humber Loop along Lake Shore Blvd. West
- A partial intersection closure is needed at Park Lawn Road and Lake Shore Blvd West.
- The closure will occur in the intersection from 10:00 a.m. on Friday, October 6 and will re-open at 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 10.
- There will be through traffic on Lake Shore Blvd West, but no north / south traffic through Lakeshore from on Park Lawn Road or Marine Parade Drive. Turns will also be restricted.
- This is the largest intersection affected by this construction project. Several other smaller closures have taken place since work started in the summer and more will take place.

### **Planned Closure Information**

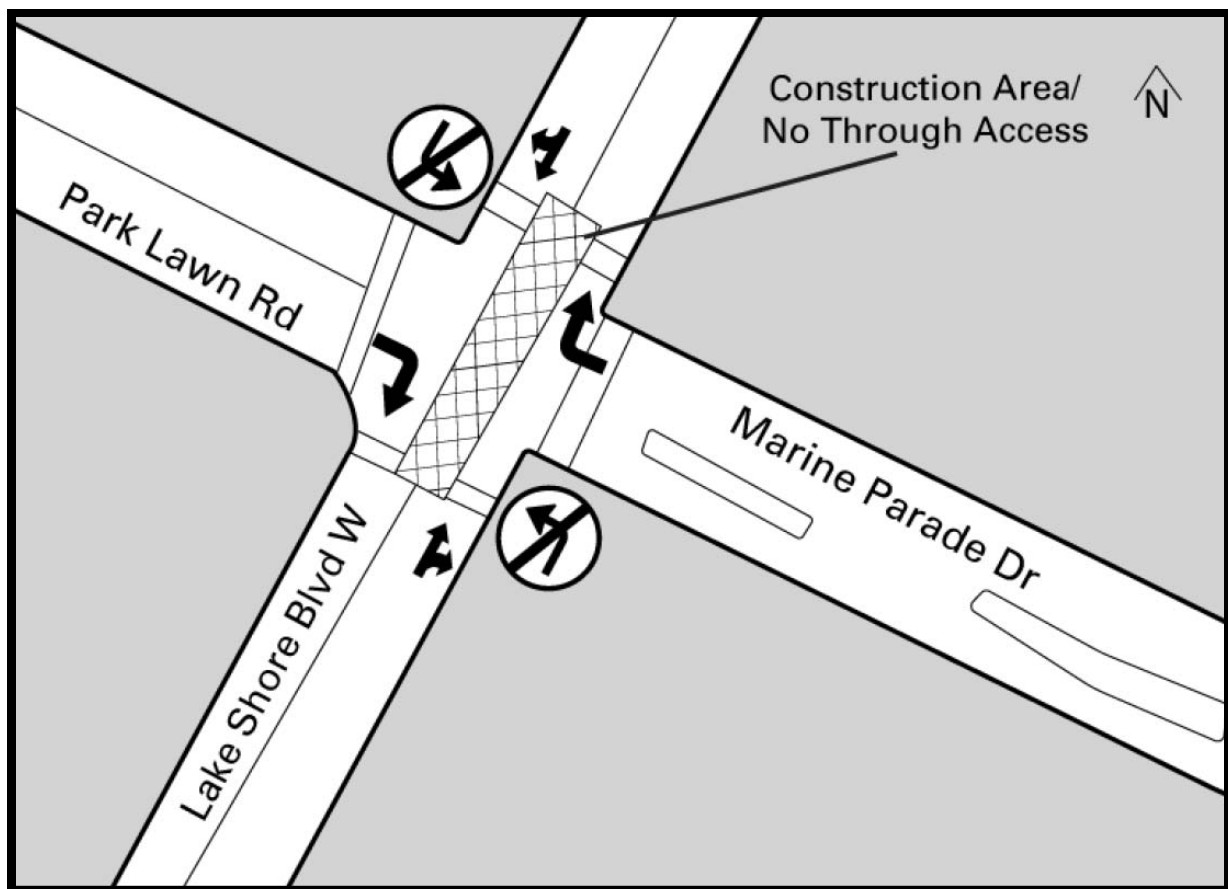
**Lake Shore Blvd West TTC Track Replacement  
Partial Intersection Closure at Lake Shore Blvd. W and Park Lawn Road  
Full Closure: 10:00 a.m. Friday, October 6, 2017  
Street Opens 6:00 a.m. Tuesday, October 10, 2017**

- Eastbound and westbound traffic on Lake Shore Boulevard West will be maintained in the curb lanes through the intersection.
- Southbound traffic on Park Lawn Road will be able to turn right onto westbound Lake Shore Boulevard West only.
- No left turns will be permitted to eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard West.
- Northbound traffic on Marine Parade Drive will be able to turn right onto eastbound Lake Shore Boulevard West only.
- No left turns will be permitted to westbound Lake Shore Boulevard. Drivers will be able to access westbound Lake Shore Boulevard West using Silver Moon Drive.
- Pedestrians will be directed around the work zone to cross over on nearby streets.
- Driveway access will not be affected
- TTC service on several routes in the area will be affected by the partial closure as noted below:
- 501L/301 Queen Buses will be maintained along regular routing.

## Planned Closure Information

- 501M Queen will operate a clockwise service linking The Queensway with Lake Shore Boulevard and Park Lawn Road
- 145 Downtown/Humber Bay Express buses will proceed west on Lake Shore Boulevard, through the Park Lawn Road intersection
- 66B Prince Edward buses will divert south on Prince Edward, east on The Queensway, south on Windermere Avenue, west on Lake Shore Boulevard, and north on Park Lawn Road.

## Key Points:

- Static and Changeable Message signage will be used to alert motorists
- Signage for pedestrians and cyclists will also be posted around the work area.
- Work will take place overnight, however there will be times of little activity while freshly poured concrete cures.

- A news release and twitter updates will be issued.
- A construction update was mailed to 18,000+ addresses and emailed to stakeholders.
