WHAT IT'S ABOUT – THE PROPOSAL:

At the property municipally known as 1400 The Queensway, the site of a waste transfer and processing facility, proposal seeking to amend the Sign By-law to allow for one third party electronic ground sign at a height of 12.19 metres and containing one sign face, measuring 3.03 metres vertically by 10.65 metres horizontally, displaying electronic static copy and directed towards westbound traffic travelling along The Queensway. The proposal also contemplates the removal of one third party (billboard) ground sign, across the street on the south side of The Queensway, located within Ward 5, and six other third party ground signs (billboards) located across the City.
