## Line 2 closed – Kipling to Jane stations Track maintenance

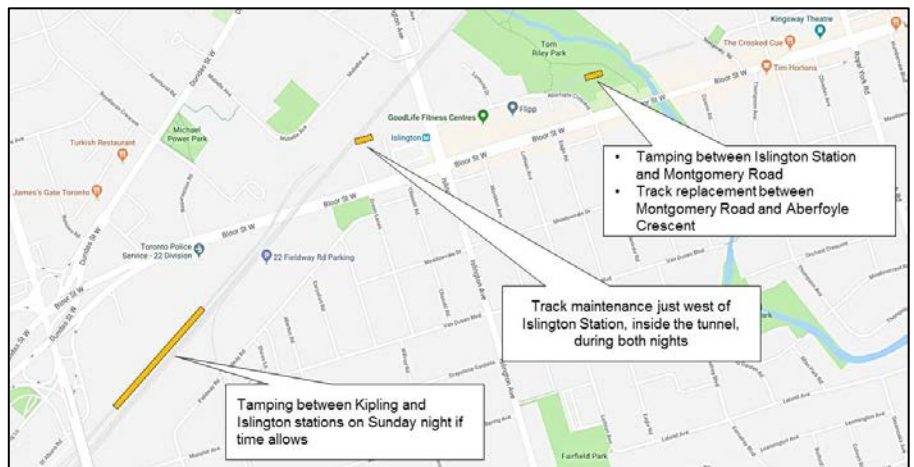
This weekend, the TTC is suspending service on Line 2 – Bloor between Kipling and Jane stations for track maintenance. Regular subway service will resume on Monday, April 16 at 6 a.m. This is the only closure of Line 2 between these stations scheduled for this year. Crews will begin working around-the-clock shortly after Friday subway service ends to ensure work completion before the start of Monday service. Equipment includes work cars and hand-held power tools; rail saws, grinders and hammer drills.

### Work activities

During this scheduled closure, track staff will conduct the following activities throughout the weekend:

- Track maintenance, including tamping inside the tunnel section west of Aberfoyle Crescent, during both nights.
- Rail replacement on the bridge between Montgomery Road and Aberfoyle Crescent during both days, with limited night activity as required.
- Tamping between Islington Station and Montgomery Road during the daytime.
- Tamping between Kipling and Islington stations on Sunday night, if time allows.



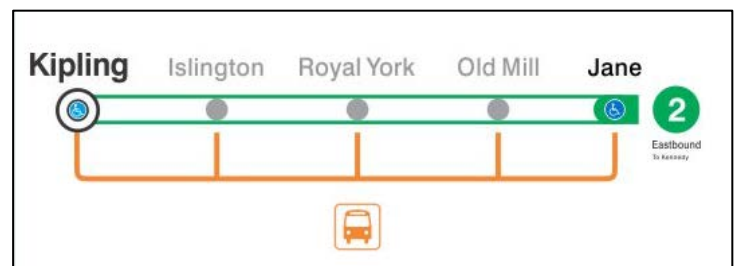
Tamping is carried out to maintain proper support by the ballast (stone) foundation that secures the track in place and helps provide for a smoother operation through the track area. Tamping can only be conducted when subway service is not running.

While we cannot eliminate all noise, our crews will do their best to keep levels to a minimum.

### TTC service

Shuttle buses and Wheel-Trans buses will operate between Kipling and Jane stations for the duration of the closure.

Regular subway service will resume on Monday at 6 a.m.
