Dundas Street West to Islington Avenue Ramp Repair over Mimico Creek

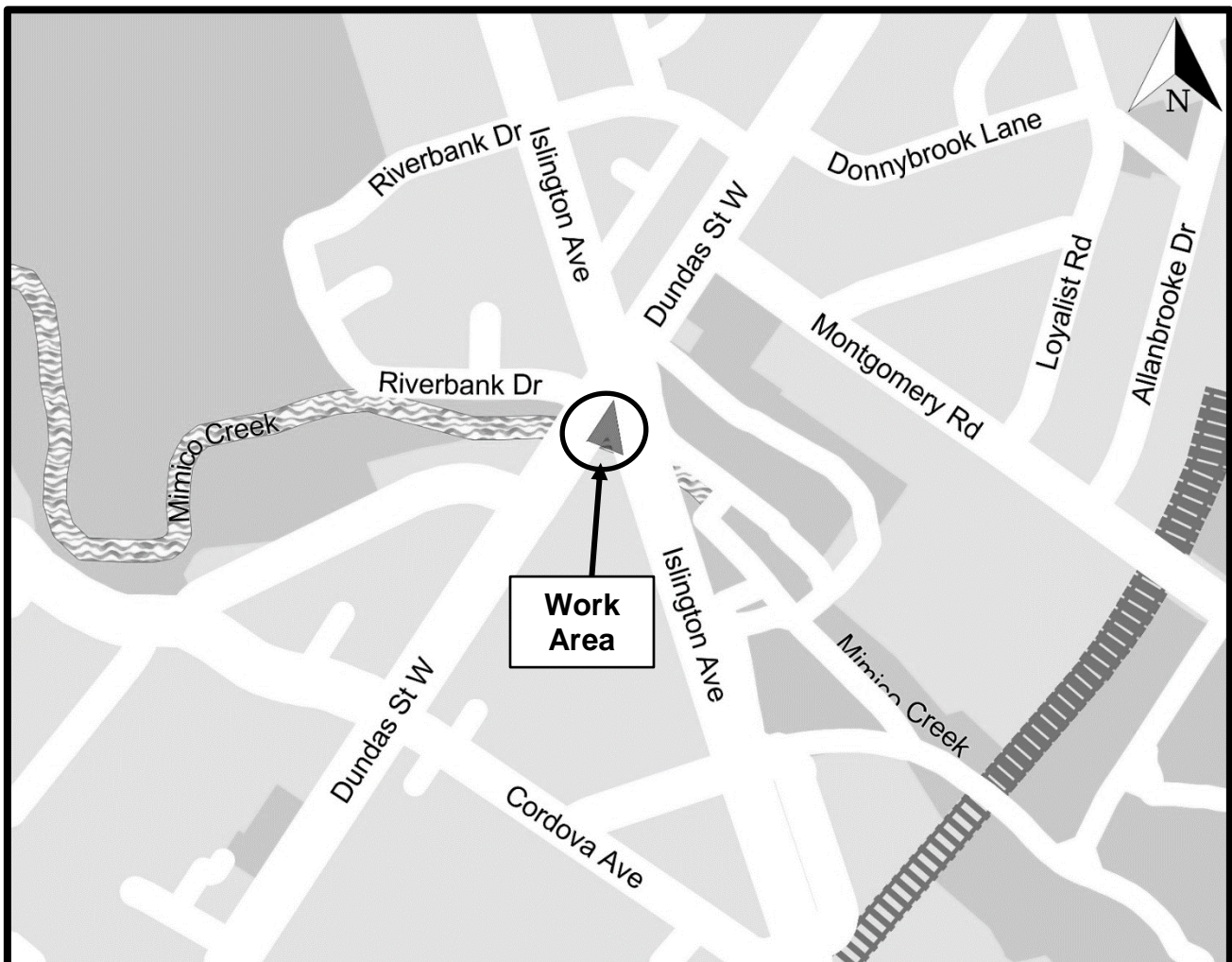
Expected Start Date: Fall 2018

The City of Toronto is planning to repair the asphalt and supporting concrete on the ramp leading from Dundas Street West eastbound to Islington Avenue southbound near the intersection of Islington Avenue and Dundas Street West (see map). This work will ensure that the bridge meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2018 Capital Works Program.

WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark sidewalks and the road with the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.
